SPECIFICATIONS FOR PAVING PROJECT

<u>PROPOSALS</u> - Before submitting your proposal, carefully examine all specifications pertaining to the work and visit the site with permission of the school district. Submission of proposal will be considered evidence that the contractor is familiar with local facilities, the requirements of the documents and of pertinent State or local codes, State Labor and Material Regulations, and has made due allowance in his/her bid for all contingencies. All contractors MUST visit the sites and verify all measurements for the bid to be considered. It is not necessary to make an appointment to visit the sites; however, the district must be notified when you intend to be on school property to conduct the necessary survey work EVEN DURING WEEKENDS AND STUDENT NON ATTENDANCE DAYS OR TIMES.

<u>OUTLINE OF PROJECT</u> - This project requires the Contractor to provide repairs and preventative maintenance for existing asphalt paved areas. This includes, but is not limited to sealing, crack filling, striping, and installation of new asphalt pavement materials.

SALES TAX - This project is exempt from Illinois Occupational Retail Sales Taxes.

<u>SCHOOL DISTRICT RIGHTS</u> - The Board of Education reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to waive any irregularities in the bidding and to make the award in accordance with the best interests of Community Consolidated School District 61.

A contract, if awarded, will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder who meets the requirements set forth in these bid specifications and, among the responsible bidders, provides the lowest total price for all services under this bid, as determined by the School District's examination of the Bidder's prices.

<u>SCOPE</u> - The contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, services, tools, equipment and incidentals required to complete the project.

The project must be completed between June 3, 2024 - July 19, 2024.

SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. Fill Cracks
- 2. Clean up and prepare the base by fuel tanks followed by 2 coats of oil and chip.

3. Prepare & Seal (ASPHALT BASED EMULSION) Specifications

- > Prepare surface Prior to placing the slurry sealing mixture, unsatisfactory areas shall be repaired and the surface of the pavement shall be clean and free from any vegetation, dust, dirt, or other loose, foreign matter, grease, oil, or any type of objectionable surface film.
- > Apply one coat of liquid asphalt covered by one application of gravel.

4. Paint (Striping)

MEASUREMENTS - The contractor shall verify all dimensions on site. The attached facility aerial photo is provided for reference purposes to identify the specific job areas. Approximated square footage for repairs or new installations is provided for reference purposes only. The contractor is responsible to examine the areas for compliance with requirements for installation and other conditions affecting performance of products per the manufacturer's requirements and specifications. Any conditions that must be altered to properly install proposed system(s) must be addressed with submission of bid in writing.

<u>INSTALLATION SCHEDULE</u> - Job can start as soon as June 3, 2024 and must be completed by or before July 19, 2024. The District is not responsible for the contractor working evenings, weekends, holidays, etc. The District reserves the right to cancel jobs depending on conflicts with other scheduled projects. Flexibility of scheduling is required to accommodate the needs of the district; however the district will accommodate the winning bidders as much as possible in this process.

<u>INSURANCE</u> - The successful bidder will supply Chester-East Lincoln CCSD #61 with a Certificate of Insurance that outlines all of their coverage and names Chester-East Lincoln CCSD #61 as an additional insured. Insurance certificates MUST be submitted BEFORE work is started.

<u>PERMITS</u> - The successful bidder will be responsible to attain permits as needed per local government requirements.

<u>PREVAILING WAGE</u> - The contractor is required to comply with all provisions of the acts of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois related to Wage Rates, Discrimination and Preference to Illinois workmen. Contractor must pay prevailing wage to all employees during the course of this project. Prevailing wage shall be as scheduled by county for which the work is contracted.
